PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

- **Mother Goose on the Loose (20 minute program for children birth to 18 months with adult)** – Join us for the nationally recognized Mother Goose on the Loose early literacy program. Enjoy interacting with your wee one as you hear stories, learn nursery rhymes and finger-plays, sing, and move with scarves, and shake bells.
- **Toddler Time (20 minute program for children 18 months to age 3 with adult)** – Stories, songs, puppets and finger-plays just for toddlers, while introducing early literacy concepts for parents and caregivers.
- **Learn and Play (2 hour program for children ages 0 to 4 with adult)** - Drop in to participate in fun activities tied to early literacy skills practice! Learn how to use reading, writing, singing, talking, and playing at home to ensure your child is ready to read.
- **Preschool Storytime (20 minute program for children 3-5 years old with adult)** – Join in the fun with stories, songs, puppets and more that encourage development of early literacy skills.
- **Little Blue Truck (90 minute program for children 0-5 years old with an adult)** - Join us for a storytime (10:00am and 11:00am) featuring Little Blue Truck's adventures, followed by a variety of themed activities and a visit from the Little Blue Truck!
- **Library Explorers (45 minute program for ages 5+)** – Explore science, art, and stories. Especially designed for school-age children to imagine, create, discover, and experiment!
- **Chess Club (1 hour program for ages 5+)** – Learn to play from an expert! Weekly sessions will be held at each branch for six weeks over the summer.
- **Lego Club (1 hour program for ages 5+)** – Calling all Lego builders! Build your own Lego creation, or collaborate with new friends. Legos are provided. *No registration required.*
- **READING Paws (15 minute time slots for children reading independently)** – Children can sign up to practice reading aloud to a therapy dog. READING Paws helps young readers gain confidence and practice fluency! *Register at the Information Desk.*
- **Glow Paint for Tweens – (1 hour program for Tweens ages 8-12)** - In a room full of blacklights, use neon paint on canvas board to make your masterpiece GLOW! **Registration required. Space is Limited**
- **Showtime for Kids: The Mystery Island Adventure (45 minute program for ages 5+ - Please choose ONE session)** - Get ready for a wacky, fun-filled adventure in search of a mysterious hidden message. During the adventure, there will be plenty of awesome magic, amazing balloons, hilarious audience participation, laugh-out-loud comedy, and The Amazing Marco!
- **Decades Party (2 hour program for kids and families)** - Jump back in time and re-live the days of the past. Children and family can participate in crafts and activities that celebrate the 1960's through the 1990's. We'll also play Music Trivia. Attendees are encouraged to dress up from their favorite decade.
