

COUNTRY CLUB HEIGHTS UTILITIES IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Community Update: August 1, 2024

The efforts to temporarily restore accessibility in the neighborhood remain ongoing. This includes street sweeping and the temporary restoration of sidewalks, driveways, and roadway for affected residents. The temporary restoration contractor has completed work on Clyde Avenue, Exeter Avenue, Burns Street, and Continental Boulevard, with only sod installation remaining in select areas. We expect to finish all temporary restoration work within the next week.

In the meantime, Seminole County is still actively working through the process to secure a new contractor for the permanent improvements and will keep you informed of any new updates. We appreciate your continued patience through this process.
